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**SCHEDULE 2 – FARM AND RURAL RESIDENTIAL – ALL-ELECTRIC**

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**Availability**

Available to an occupied residence, including adjacent farm buildings and other farm use, except for crop irrigation, with 50 kVA or less required transformer capacity, located within an area served by Norris Public Power District prior to May 1, 2017, when electric service is measured by one meter. The residence must use electricity exclusively for all normal uses, including water heating and permanently installed space heating equipment equal to the design heating load of the dwelling.

**Type of Service**

Single-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltages.

**Fuel and Production Cost Adjustment**

A fuel and production cost adjustment may be applied to all energy used in an amount per kWh equal to the increase or decrease in the District's cost due to the most recent fuel and production cost adjustment from the District's power supplier plus an adjustment for system energy losses based on the previous calendar years' experience.

**Minimum Charge**

The minimum monthly charge shall be the greater of \$26.00 or \$1.40 per kVA of required transformer capacity.

**Late Charge**

If payment is not received by the due date as indicated on the bill, 5% will be added to the bill as a late charge.

**Summer and Winter Seasons**

The summer rates will apply to customer bills rendered between June 15<sup>th</sup> and October 15<sup>th</sup>. The winter rates will apply to the remaining months of the year.

**Service Regulation**

The District's Service Regulations are incorporated herein as part of this Schedule.
