SCHEDULE S10, S11, S14, S16 and S17 – IRRIGATION SERVICE SINGLE OR MULTIPHASE

General Availability

Available to customers who meet the requirements of the former Seward County Public Power District Rate Schedules 10, 11, 14, 16 or 17 and are located within an area served by Seward County Public Power District prior to May 1, 2017. Available to seasonal power customers for irrigation pump motors, tower wheel motors, re-use pits and booster pumps.

Type of Service

Single-phase or three-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltages.

Irrigation Season

Irrigation season shall be from May 1 through September 30.

Fuel and Production Cost Adjustment

A fuel and production cost adjustment including system energy losses based on the previous calendar years' experience may be applied to all energy used in an amount per kWh equal to the increase or decrease in the District's cost due to the fuel and production cost adjustment charged to the District by its power supplier during the irrigation season.

Municipal Agreement Charge

Where the District has an agreement to pay the municipality a percentage of the customer's retail revenue, such percentage will be added to each customer's bill before application of a fuel and production cost adjustment.

Determination of Horsepower

Determination of horsepower for initial billing purposes shall be the motor manufacturer's nameplate rating of horsepower output. After the first operating season, subsequent horsepower billings will be determined after a period of maximum normal use during the previous irrigation season measured by a demand meter, divided by .746. In the event of a season or seasons which do not produce a typical demand reading, the District will use its last valid kW reading as a substitute.

The District will install demand meters on all new irrigation services, those requiring maintenance, and also in the event a customer requests a motor horsepower testing on an existing service. Demand readings will measure total component load on the irrigation system including motor, boosters, and wheels where applicable.

The minimum billed horsepower shall be 15 horsepower, regardless of measured demand.

Idle Service Billing

All idled irrigation services will be billed annually an idle service charge equal to 50% of the Rate S17 HP charge.

Service Regulations

The District's Service Regulations are incorporated herein as part of these schedules.

RATE S10 – IRRIGATION THREE PHASE - ANNUAL

Availability

Available to customers who meet the requirements of the former Seward County Public Power District Rate Schedule 10 and are located within an area served by Seward County Public Power District prior to May 1, 2017. This rate schedule is closed to new customers. New customers will be directed to Rate Schedule S14.

Customer Charge \$378.00

Energy Charge, per kWh

All kWh \$0.1270

Minimum charge is the Customer Charge or \$12.00 per installed transformer KVA, whichever is greater.

Operating Schedule

Power available 100% of time, with exception of scheduled or unscheduled outages.

RATE S11 - IRRIGATION SINGLE PHASE - ANNUAL

Availability

Available to customers who meet the requirements of the former Seward County Public Power District Rate Schedule 11 and are located within an area served by Seward County Public Power District prior to May 1, 2017. This rate schedule is closed to new customers. New customers will be directed to Rate Schedule S14.

Customer Charge \$225.00

Energy Charge, per kWh

All kWh \$0.1270

Operating Schedule

Power available 100% of time, with exception of scheduled or unscheduled outages.

RATE S14 - IRRIGATION SERVICE NO CONTROL

Availability

Available to customers who meet the requirements of the former Seward County Public Power District Rate Schedule 14 and are located within an area served by Seward County Public Power District prior to May 1, 2017. Available to motors of all sizes.

Power available 100% of time, with exception of scheduled or unscheduled outages.

RATE S16 – THREE-DAY CONTROL

Availability

Available to customers who meet the requirements of the former Seward County Public Power District Rate Schedule 16 and are located within an area served by Seward County Public Power District prior to May 1, 2017. Available to motors greater than 20 HP.

Energy Charge, per kWh/HP

First 300 kWh x HP \$0.1375 All additional kWh 0.0815

Operating Schedule

The District reserves the right to assign the customer to either Schedule 1 or 2.

- 1. Power will be available all day on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, plus the minimum hours of 11:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and eighteen (18) hours on Sunday.
- 2. Power will be available all day on Thursday, Friday, Saturday, plus the minimum hours of 11:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and eighteen (18) hours on Sunday.

- 3. No services will be interrupted more than twelve (12) hours in any one day Monday through Saturday.
 - 4. No services will be interrupted more than six (6) hours on Sunday.
- 5. Power will be available on Memorial Day and Labor Day but may be interrupted on Independence Day. No services will be interrupted more than six (6) hours on Independence Day.
- 6. Interruptions are made only on days when peak power levels are being exceeded. At its discretion, the District may interrupt service during operating hours normally allowed if the District's power supplier requests emergency control.

RATE S17 – IRRIGATION FULL CONTROL

Availability

Available to customers who meet the requirements of the former Seward County Public Power District Rate Schedule 17 and are located within an area served by Seward County Public Power District prior to May 1, 2017. Available to motors greater than 20 HP.

Energy Charge, per kWh/HP

First 300 kWh x HP \$0.1375 All additional kWh 0.0740

Operating Schedule

Power will be available on Sunday through Saturday for the minimum hours of 11:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m. Customers will be notified each day prior to 9:00 a.m. if any operations will not be allowed for the hours from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.

- 1. No services will be interrupted more than twelve (12) hours in any one day Monday through Saturday or more than seventy-two (72) hours in any one calendar week.
 - 2. No services will be interrupted more than six (6) hours on Sunday.
- 3. Power will be available on Memorial Day and Labor Day but may be interrupted on Independence Day. No services will be interrupted more than six (6) hours on Independence Day.
- 4. Interruptions are made only on days when peak power levels are being exceeded. At its discretion, the District may interrupt service during operating hours normally allowed if the District's power supplier requests emergency control.
